You should complete at least one clause from each group below, plus others making a suggested total of

5 for Rainbows

8 for Brownies

11 for Guides

14 for Senior Section, Leaders & Trefoil Guild

Clauses can be completed individually, or as six/patrol or as a unit. Units who are not part of Girlguiding Dundee should omit the "Dundee Events" group.



Dundee Events

- 1) Attend the launch at the Caird Hall (7th Feb 2015)
- 2) Follow the Dundee Women's Trail / Dundee City Trail
- 3) Take part in the 2015 County Camp
- 4) Participate in one of the other Girlguiding Dundee Centenary events

History

- 1) Complete the Brownie or Guide traditions badge
- 2) As a unit, or a patrol, find & interview the oldest member of Girlguiding in your area
- 3) Complete some clauses from the 1950s Brownie Golden Hand Test
 - (a) know 15 letters of the alphabet in semaphore and be able to send & receive simple words
 - (b) be able to set a compass & know eight points
 - (c) knit a small, useful article
 - (d) fold clothes neatly
 - (e) skip 30 times without a break, turning the rope backwards
 - (f) throw a ball overarm, to land over a line seven yards away with two side lines three yards apart
 - (g) clean shoes
 - (h) carry a message of at least 12 words in your head for over five minutes and deliver it correctly
- 4) Find out about your local area 100 years ago

Dundee - One City, Many Discoveries

- 1) Complete the Brownie Stargazer badge
- 2) Complete the Brownie Science Investigator or Guide Science badge
- 3) Take a normal sized matchbox and discover how many things you can fit into it
- 4) Discover your local area: take part in or help to organise an outdoor activity in your local area

Growing Guiding

- 1) Think up some ideas for how you could promote Girlguiding in your local area
- 2) Take part in (Rainbows/Brownies) or help to organise (Guides upwards) an event with another section
- 3) Bring a friend along to your unit
- 4) Make a poster to advertise your unit or Girlguiding in general, and display it at your meeting place or school

The Future

- 1) Make a Time Capsule for your unit, and store it safely.
- 2) Decide on some guidelines for your unit to save energy now which will help future generations
