What to Take

Here's a suggested list what you need to take with you:

**The Holiday House:**

1. Arrival and Departure Checklists
2. The beds are all single but there is no bed linen for hire (there is some emergency linen in the leaders room). The mattresses have protectors but for hygiene reasons (and comfort) **must** be covered. So, each person **must** bring:
  - a. 1 bottom sheet
  - b. 1 pillowcase
  - c. 1 sleeping bag or duvet plus cover
3. £1 coins for electric meters for heating and sockets -  
Can be up to £60 required in winter months.
4. First Aid equipment
5. Tea towels / Dish cloths / Oven Gloves / Hand towels for kitchen and washrooms
6. Food storage containers
7. Toilet rolls and non-antibacterial hand-wash (Antibacterial is bad for our septic tank)
8. Cleaning materials (floor cleaner is supplied and must be used on all floors)  
**Please use Septic tank friendly products**
9. Pedal and Swing bin liners
10. Small bin bags for sanitary bins (individual sanitary bags are provided in each cubical)
11. Poly sacks for rubbish

**The Campsite and or Wigwams:**

1. Arrival and Departure Checklists

4. Tea towels / Dish cloths
5. Hand towels
