1.	Arrival and Departure Checklists	
2.	All beds are single. There is no bed linen for hire. The mattresses have protectors but for hygiene reasons (and comfort) must be covered. Therefore, each person must bring:

3.	£2 and £1 coins for the electric meters in the kitchen which power the sockets and heating in that section. £1 coins only for heating in the dormitories though (leaders room downstairs). Can be up to £60 required in winter months.	
4.	Washing Machine & Dishwasher. Please bring your own tablets/fabric conditioner. No powder to be used.	
5.	First Aid Equipment	
6.	Tea Towels/Dish Cloths/Oven Gloves/Hand Towels for Kitchen and Washrooms	
7.	Food Storage Containers	
8.	Toilet Rolls & Non-Antibacterial Handwash (Antibacterial is bad for our septic tank)	
9.	Cleaning Materials (please use septic tank friendly products)	
10.	Small bin bags for sanitary bins	
11.	Black bags for rubbish	

Make sure there is enough money in the relevant meters for your use. Please do not put in any extra. Leave enough for emergencies and checkers after your booking however - do not leave completely empty. Meters for sockets and heating in the dormitories are in the leader's room downstairs.

Your checklist which is available on the website must be brought and at the end of your booking left in the kitchen. Without this you will not know departure procedures and what needs cleaned etc. This checklist is also a confirmation that you have left the house as you found it. If it is not completed and there is an issue with the house, then you could be possibly charged with a Cleaning Penalty of £30.
